*Spirometry Workshop for Family Physicians Following the GOLD Standard: Treating COPD in Primary Care

This workshop will address the significant barriers that currently exist in the FP's office with respect to the use of spirometry when diagnosing patients with COPD. The workshop will be a one hour, hands-on, case-based patient simulated and designed for 30 participants. Eight of the 30 participants that enroll in the workshop will be invited to participate in the outcomes measurement part of the program. Participants should be enrolled and registered for the workshop by July 1, 2008. Eight of the workshop physicians may participate in an AXDEV facilitated discussion group prior to the live workshop and then a one hour telephone interview three months following the workshop. Participants will be reimbursed \$350 for their time during the discussion group and upon completion of a post workshop questionnaire and \$200 for their time during the telephone interview.
