KSA GROUP LEARNING SESSION (formerly SAM Session)

Please join us for our KSA Group Learning Sessions on Diabetes and Care of the Vulnerable Elderly. The Clinical Self-Assessment (formerly Clinical Simulation) is no longer required and is an optional activity. All results from the KSA will be automatically transmitted to the ABFM. CONTINUING MEDICAL EDUCATION CREDIT: This program has been submitted to the American Academy of Family Physicians for up to 45.5 Prescribed Credits (plus an additional 8.0 Prescribed Credits for each KSA session).

Physician Credit: AAFP Prescribed Credit is accepted by the AMA as equivalent to AMA PRA Category 1 for the AMA Physicians Recognition Award. When applying for AMA PRA, prescribed credits earned must be reported as Prescribed Credits, not as Category 1. Each physician should claim only those credits that he/she actually spent in the educational activity. One hour of lecture equals one credit. Program evaluation must be completed and turned in to receive credit.
