2022 NAFP Winter CME Meeting COVID-19 Policy

As frontline healthcare workers, family physicians are at very high risk for contracting COVID-19. The NAFP expects all attendees at the 2022 NAFP Winter CME Meeting to be vaccinated against COVID-19, as these vaccines are very safe and effective at preventing severe illness.

The NAFP is implementing this policy for the safety of each other as well as be an example for our patients and the community at large. We acknowledge that COVID-19 continues to be a rapidly evolving situation and, as such, we will promptly communicate any updates/changes to this policy when appropriate. We will be enforcing the following guidelines on-site at Harrah's Lake Tahoe and Harveys Lake Tahoe:

- Attendees and their guests will be required to wear a face covering while on-site in the NAFP meeting spaces. Individuals refusing to wear a face covering/mask will be asked to leave the meeting space(s)—no exceptions.
- Education rooms and food function areas will be redesigned to accommodate appropriate physical distancing guidelines. Attendees are required to follow on-site protocols for a clean, safe, and socially responsible meeting experience.
- Physical meeting attendance is at the attendees' own risk and NAFP will not be liable for sickness, death, injury suffered by any person, including accompanying persons, partner, or caregivers.
- The NAFP will provide the most recent safety information available and expects attendees to accept that the content and/or delivery of the event can change at any time beyond the control of the NAFP.
