ACCREDITATION

CONTINUING MEDICAL EDUCATION CREDIT: This program has been submitted to the American Academy of Family Physicians for up to **41.5 Prescribed Credits** (plus an additional 8.0 Prescribed Credits for each KSA session).

Physician Credit: AAFP Prescribed Credit is accepted by the AMA as equivalent to AMA PRA Category 1 for the AMA Physicians Recognition Award. When applying for AMA PRA, prescribed credits earned must be reported as Prescribed Credits, not as Category 1. Each physician should claim only those credits that he/she actually spent in the educational activity. One hour of lecture equals one credit. Program evaluation must be completed and turned in to receive credit.
